### CRITERIA TO EARN DELEGATE/ALTERNATE POSITION FOR STATE CONVENTION

This system will reward those who are faithful in helping the Grimes County Republican Party grow and achieve its goals, and will eliminate favoritism or perception of favoritism in selecting persons to fill positions at the state convention, which will occur in June of even numbered years.

Credit will be awarded for the time period from after the primary election to the next primary election. (March to March). Credits can be earned by an individual's participation in the above GCRP recognized activities.

The Vice Chairman will be responsible for accepting the monthly activity reports from each participant, and verify that the information submitted is legitimate and acceptable. Each person will be responsible for submitting this form monthly to the Vice Chairman, with an adequate explanation of activities and total hours worked. Points are subject to verification and approval by the Vice Chairman.

Selection of delegates and alternates will be first to the person with the highest approved points, then next highest and so forth. Anyone who earns a slot and does not desire to attend the state convention can decline and will be replaced by the person with the next highest points. All persons selected should definitely plan to participate. If participation is uncertain, the selection should be declined so the state party's resources will not be wasted.

\* The Vice Chairman may award extra points for excessive volunteer hours, at his/her discretion, based upon the formula:  
1 point = 8 hours of volunteer service
